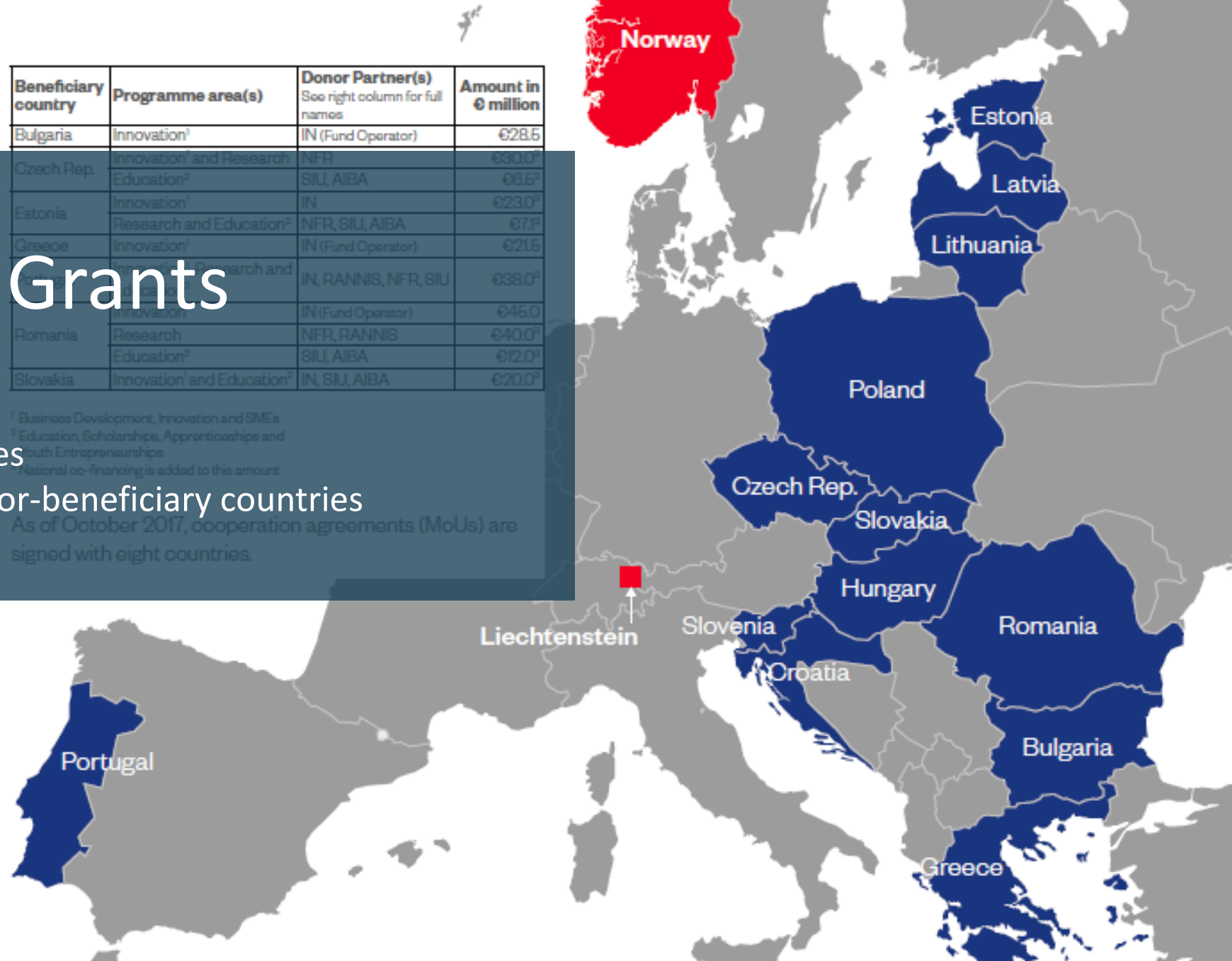

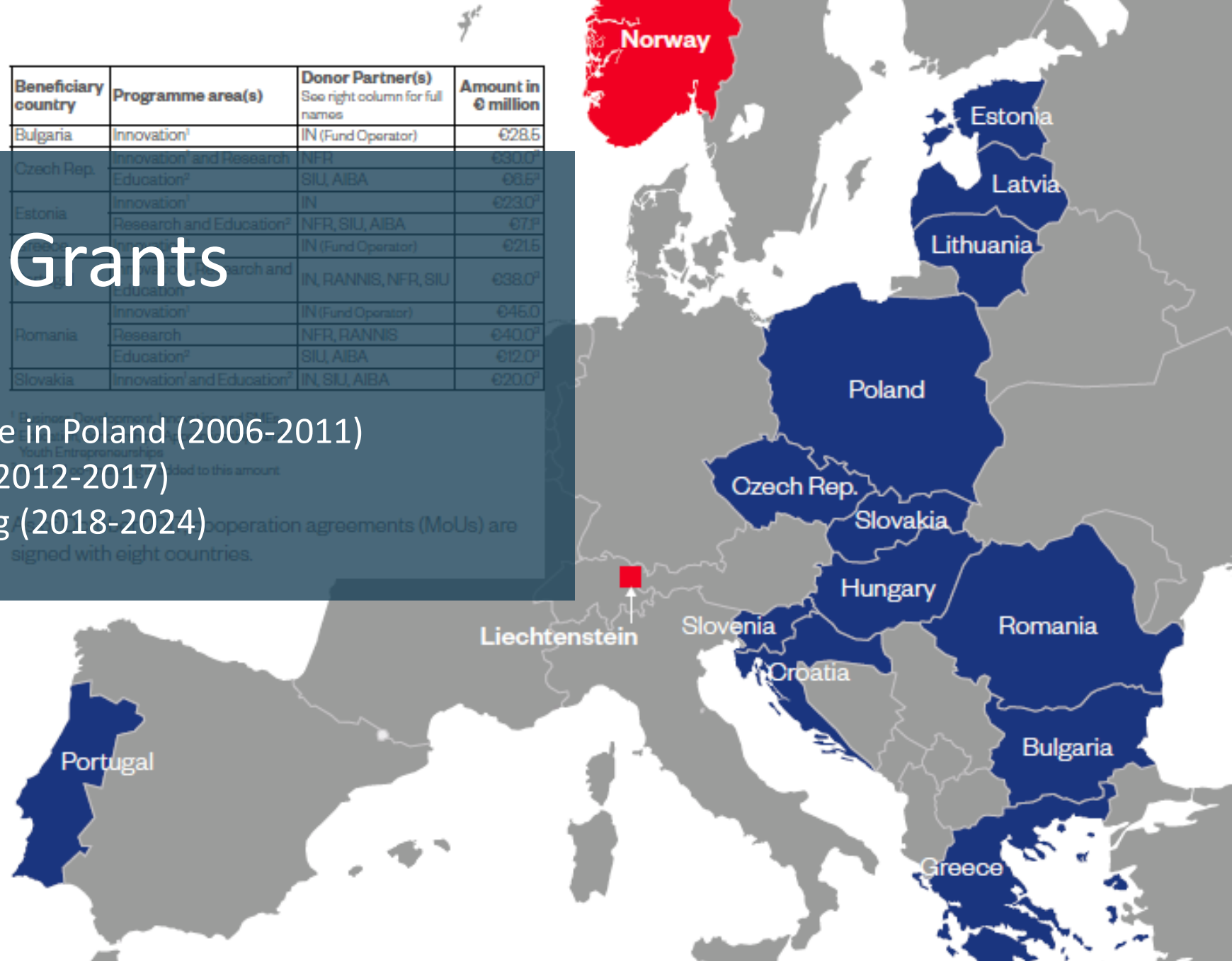

EØS-midlene 2014-2021

Sammen for et grønt, konkurransedyktig og inkluderende Europa

Norge samarbeider tett med EU. EØS-avtalen er bunnplanken i dette samarbeidet. Avtalen inkluderer en felles målsetting om å arbeide sammen for å redusere sosiale og økonomiske ulikheter i Europa. EØS-midlene er Norges bidrag til dette.

For perioden 2014-2021 skal Norge bidra med om lag 2,8 milliarder euro til 15 av EUs mindre velstående medlemsland. Europa deler felles verdigrunnlag og trenger felles løsninger på felles utfordringer. Derfor gjennomføres EØS-midlene i nært samarbeid med norske aktører. De fem områdene innsatsen skal rettes mot, både supplerer og utfyller EUs egne utjevningfond:

- 1) **Innovasjon, forskning, utdanning og konkurransekraft**
- 2) **Sosial inkludering, ungdomsledighet og fattigdomsbekjempelse**
- 3) **Miljø, energi, klimaendringer og lavkarbonøkonomi**
- 4) **Kultur, siviltf samfunn, godt styresett og grunnleggende rettigheter**
- 5) **Justis- og innenrikssaker**

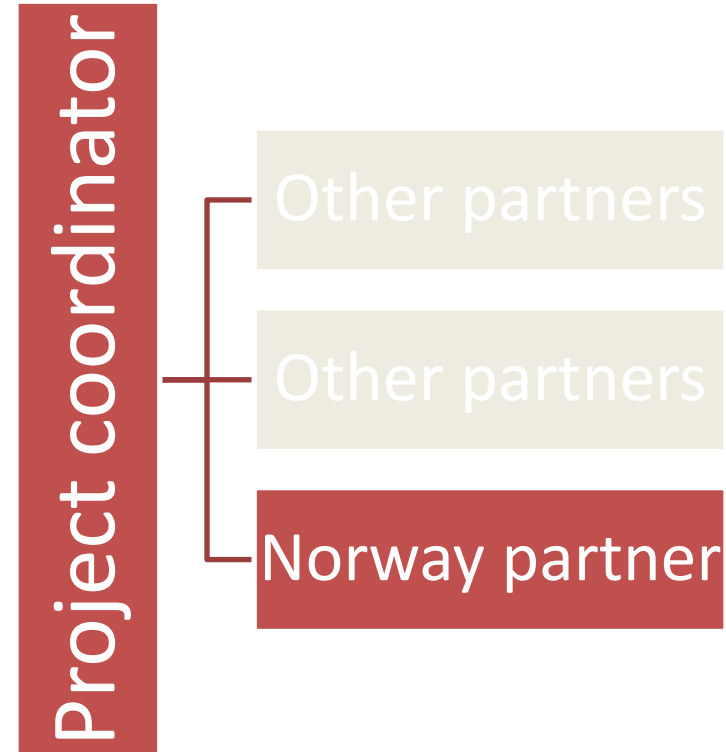
Different programme portfolios per country

Research programmes – specific group with different rules - *à la H2020*



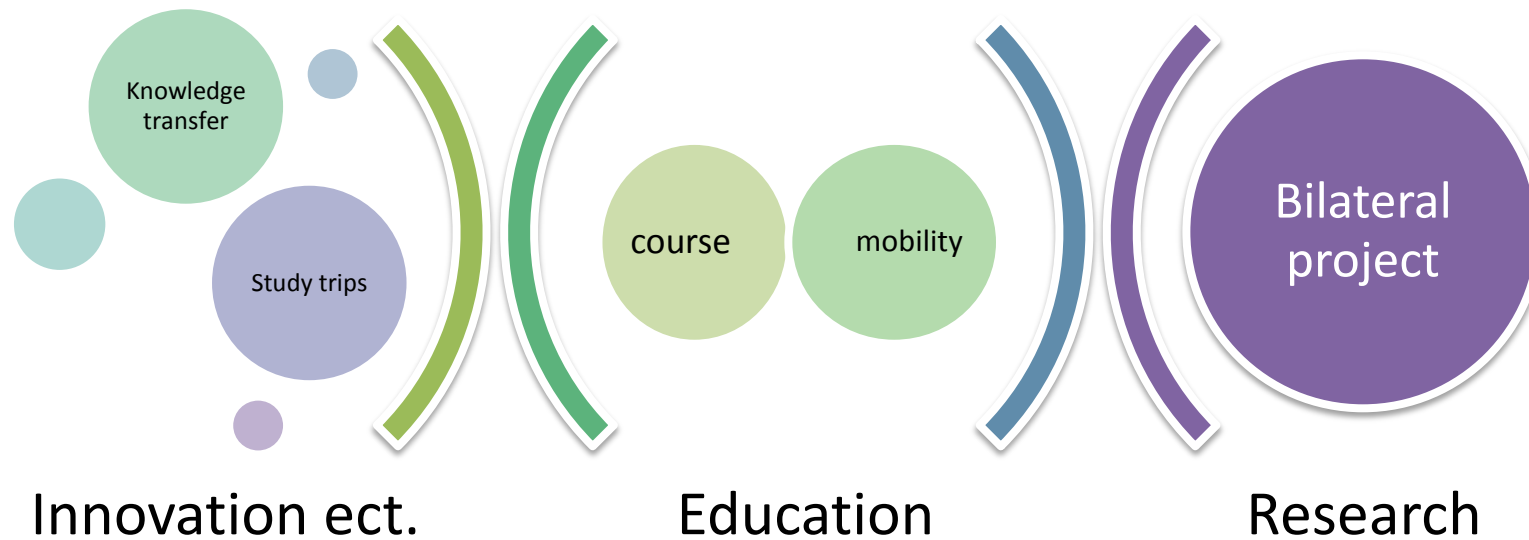
Research programmes – basic ingredient

- Regulation based on EUs FP + national rules



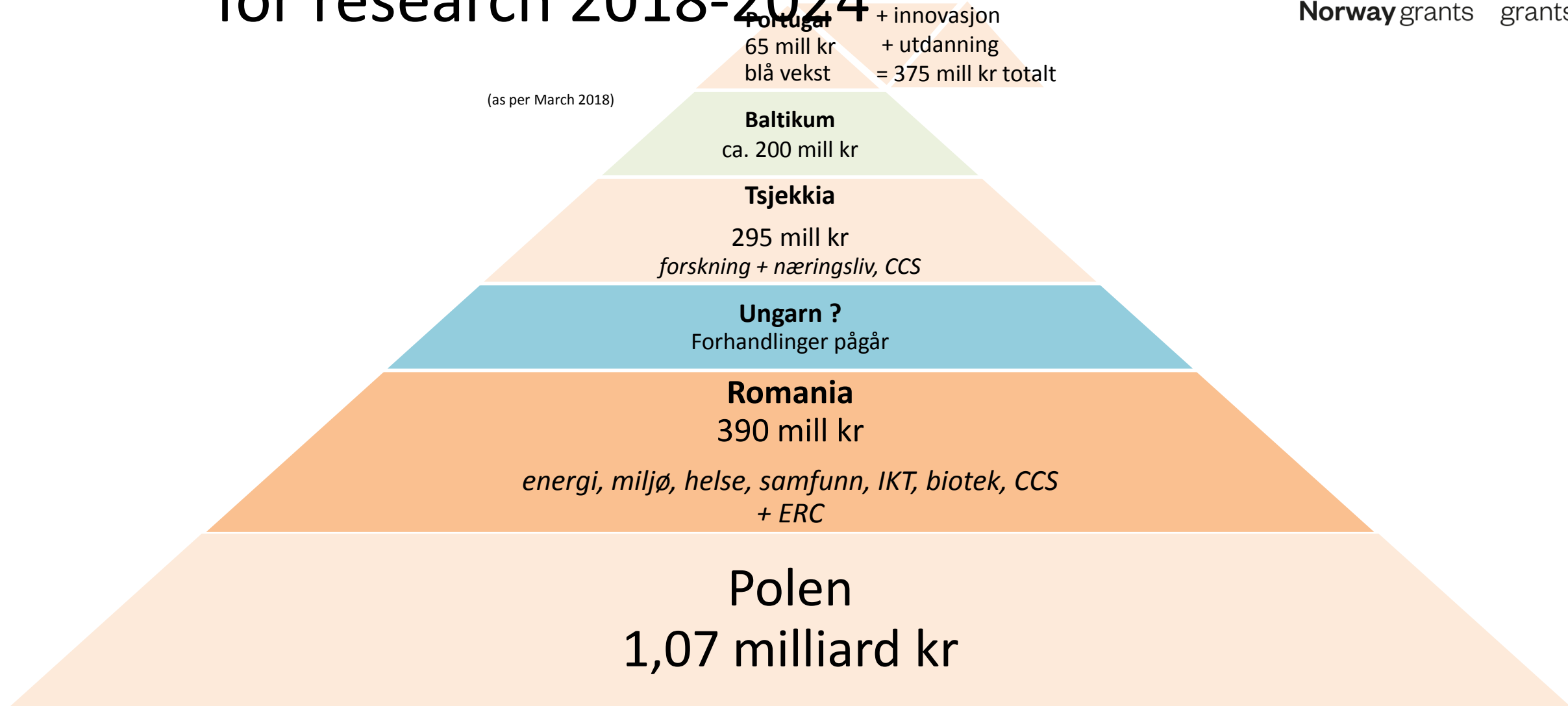


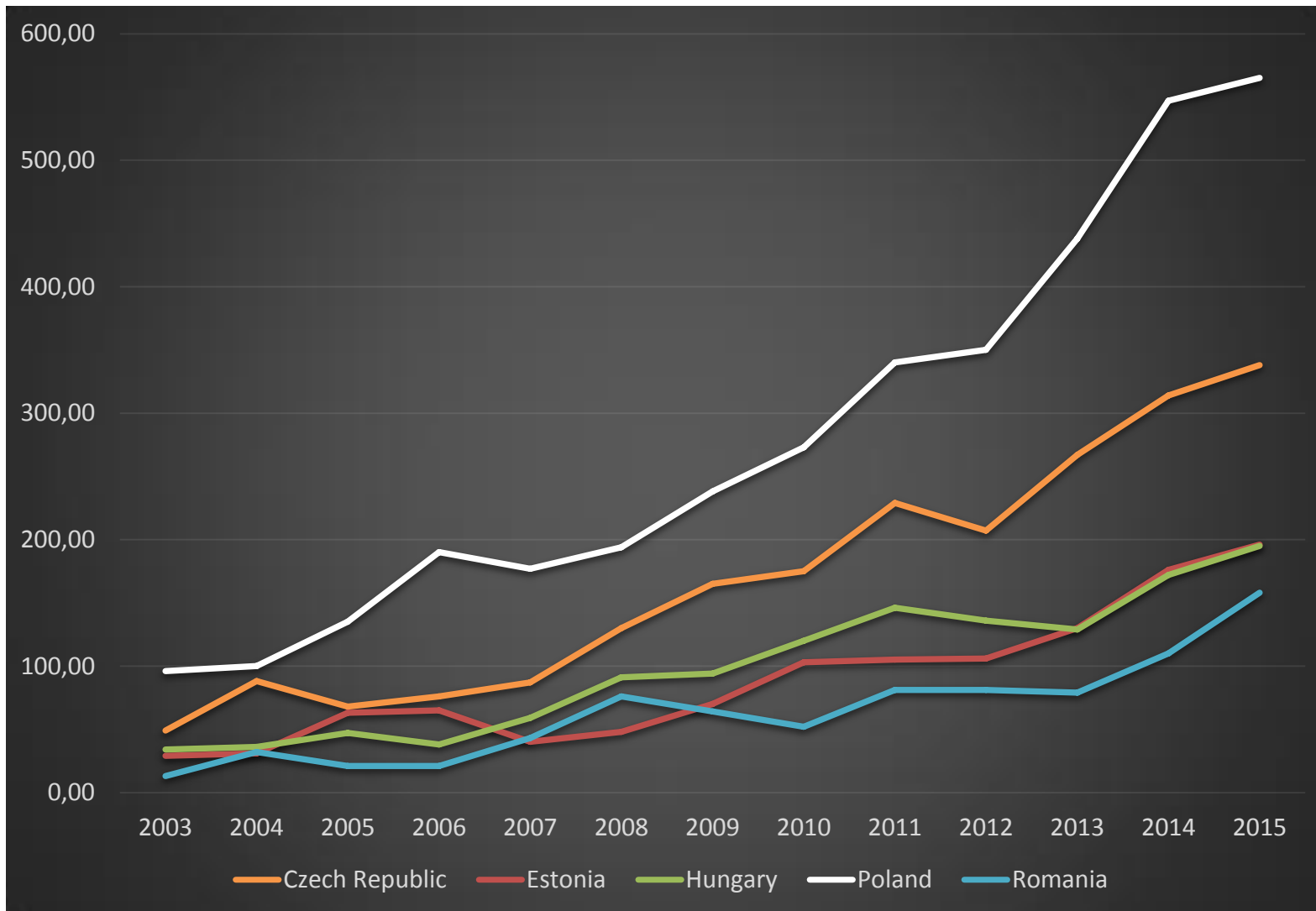

EEA and Norway Grants for research 2018-2024



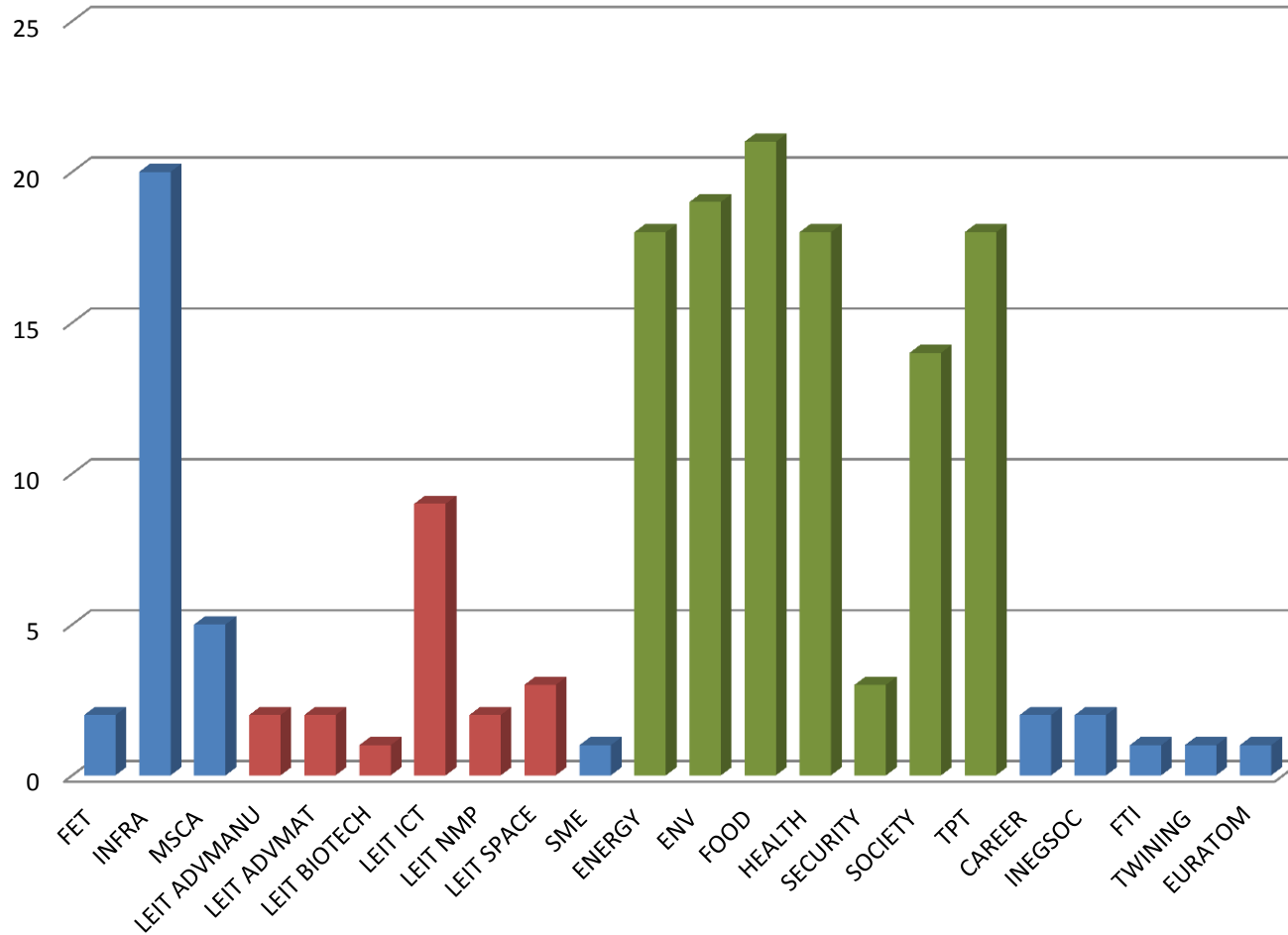


Ambition 1: Bilateral Research Cooperation
