Aims:

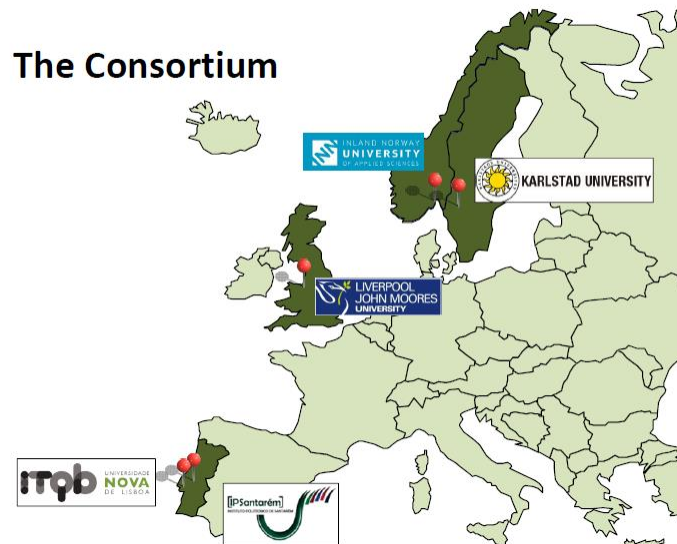
- Deliver generic skills training that will enhance researchers' employability for careers within and beyond academia
