Developing a Joint PhD collaboration

- Accreditation documentation to both national bodies
- Agreement does the existing agreement cover PhD level?
- Develop <u>a joint study plan</u> for the PhD program
 - Degree versus program important to differentiate; different criteria
 - Allocate responsibilities who's program manager, who's responsible for which parts in a joint PhD program and who's...
 - Mobility timeline for the student
- Supervisors names and academic degree (8/4-criteria)
 - Each PhD candidate <u>shall have at least two supervisors</u> with shared academic-related responsibility for the candidate



Requirements that cannot be waived

- Admission requirements (5 year master)
- The doctoral thesis must be made <u>available to the</u> <u>public</u>
- The <u>public defense</u> must be evaluated by an impartial committee
- All academic supervisors must hold a doctoral degree or equivalent qualification in the relevant research field and be working actively as researchers.



PhD course

- Access to each others ordinary PhD courses
 - Guarantee admission for partners
 - Teach in English
 - Mutual recognition
- Cooperating courses av PhD level
 - Joint teaching
 - Collaborate in study plan development
- Required coursework
